CLOVIS, CALIF.,—March 30, 2020, The Central California Conference of Seventh-day Adventists (CCC) continues to monitor the COVID-19 status and information from the appropriate agencies, and is hereby directing and requiring that:

- (1) All CCC churches (including companies and church plants) cease all gatherings for church-related events at church locations until Monday, May 4, 2020; and
- (2) All CCC schools cease all gatherings for school-related events at school locations until Monday, May 4, 2020. School staff will return to campus on that date. Students will return to campus for on-campus instruction on Tuesday, May 5, 2020. Until that time, academic instruction continues via schoolwork assignments that will be given via hardcopy learning packets and/or online instruction.
- (3) As for our preschools, they will each follow the directions of the federal, state, county, Conference Education Department, and local Preschool Board to determine the operational status of preschools.
- (4) For the remainder of the current school year, students of Monterey Bay Academy (MBA) will receive online instruction, and the school campus will remain closed to school-related gatherings and events. Further details pertaining to graduation will be shared later by MBA Principal, Elder Jeff Deming.

As we face the challenges of the global Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, the above actions have been made with much consideration for the health and safety of our members, students and families, and the people of the communities in which we live and serve.

Thank you for your prayers and support as we move closer to the soon return of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.
